

FINAL REPAIR OPPORTUNITY NOTICE GEORGIA LEMON LAW

Pursuant to the Georgia Lemon Law, O.C.G.A. Section 10-1-784(a)(2), this is my notice as a consumer that the manufacturer's authorized agent has been unable to repair or correct the nonconformity or nonconformities (defects) listed below in the new motor vehicle described below. I am notifying you, the manufacturer, that you have an opportunity for a final repair attempt.

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INSTRUCTIONS

The Final Repair Opportunity is covered in the book *Lemon-Aid for Georgia Consumers*.

1. You are ineligible to use this form if:
 - a. you purchased or leased your vehicle as “used”;
 - b. your truck is more than 12,000 GVWR;
 - c. your vehicle is a limousine, motorcycle, or ATV.
2. Only list those defects that have met the required repair attempts.
3. Locate the manufacturer’s notification address for reporting warranty issues in the warranty manual or owner’s manual.
4. Car and truck consumers: Send the completed form to the manufacturer at its notification address by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by overnight mail.
5. Motor home consumers: You must send this form separately to both the coach and chassis manufacturers at their notification addresses.
6. Keep a copy of this form and the mailing receipts with tracking numbers for your records.
7. Mail or fax a copy of the completed form to the Georgia Department of Law, Consumer Protection Division.
