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## INSTRUCTIONS

The Repurchase or Replacement Request is covered in the book *Lemon-Aid for Georgia Consumers*.

1. You are ineligible to use this form if:
  - a. you purchased or leased your vehicle as “used”;
  - b. your truck is more than 12,000 GVWR;
  - c. your vehicle is a limousine, motorcycle, or ATV.
2. Locate the manufacturer’s notification address for reporting warranty issues in the warranty manual or owner’s manual.
3. Car and truck consumers: Send the completed form to the manufacturer at its notification address by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by overnight mail.
4. Motor home consumers: You must send this form separately to both the coach and chassis manufacturers at their notification addresses.
5. Keep a copy of this form and the mailing receipts with tracking numbers for your records.
6. Mail or fax a copy of the completed form to the Georgia Department of Law, Consumer Protection Division.
